

## Independent Chairman & Members of UKPAC

The UK PAC Implementation Team is looking to appoint a Chairman and two board members to take the lead in setting the strategic direction of the newly formed UK Public Affairs Council. The UK PAC aims to promote public confidence in those who undertake lobbying by encouraging transparency and accountability among those it regulates. The Chairman will guide the work of the UK PAC and act as a respected figurehead for the lobbying industry and promote high ethical standards, transparency and accountability.

Independent members of the UK PAC will be required to attend Board meetings, deputise for the Chairman as required and contribute to the achievement of the UK PAC's objectives.

The UK PAC Implementation Team is looking for applications from individuals who have a detailed understanding of the UK political system, previous experience of regulatory or self-regulatory processes and who are able to command the confidence of the industry and other key stakeholders. The Chairman must be able to represent the UK PAC to government, other political institutions, the media and more generally. They should also have the ability to speak with confidence and integrity for those involved in or advising on lobbying.
